



SFHA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

GENERAL:

The SFHA awards three \$500 scholarships each year to two midget players and one juvenile player in recognition of academic achievement and community/school service combined with hockey participation. The SFHA Scholarship Program wishes to encourage hockey players to continue their involvement in Minor Hockey while achieving their academic goals. The eligibility requirements for this award are set out hereunder.

Eligibility

To be eligible, players must be:

- (1) currently registered with the SFHA Midget or Juvenile divisions; and
- (2) completing their final year of grade 12, or finished high school; and
- (3) in the application process or enrolled in post secondary education

An individual may receive not more than one award from the SFHA Scholarship Program in a playing season. Where a candidate is eligible to receive more than one award in a given year, he or she shall receive the scholarship with the higher monetary value. A scholarship winner shall be eligible to win a scholarship or bursary in any subsequent year of eligibility.

Scholarships to be awarded on the following criteria:

- (1) Academic achievement.
- (2) Good school and community participation and service.
- (3) Participation within the Surrey Female Hockey Association.

How to Apply

Applicants should complete the SFHA Scholarship Application Form (available on the SFHA web site - see below) **and** submit a personal letter containing an outline of academic achievements, community/school participation and service, and other qualifications. In addition, the following must accompany the application:

- (1) Letter from a designated executive member, or SFHA team official.
- (2) Letter of reference from one of the following: school Principal or teacher, or team official/coach outside of the SFHA.
- (3) Copy of transcript of high school grades.

Selection Committee

Applications will be reviewed by an independent adjudication committee consisting of a respected educator(s) and independent hockey official (s). Selections will be approved by the Scholarship Committee and Executive Committee.
